

## DISQUALIFIERS (CONT.)

### Misdemeanor Crimes of Violence:

1. Assault – 2903.13
2. Aggravated Menacing – 2903.21
3. Menacing by Stalking – 2903.21.1
4. Menacing – 2903.22
5. Arson – 2909.03
6. Riot – 2917.03
7. Endangering Children – 2919.22
8. Intimidation of Victim/Witness – 2921.04
9. Escape – 2921.34
10. Discharge firearm at or into Habitation or School Safety Zone – 2923.16.1

5) If applicant has been convicted under the following offenses within 5 years.;

- a. 2 or more assaults
- b. 2 or more negligent assaults

6) If applicant has been convicted under the following offenses within 10 years:

- a. Resisting arrest

7) If applicant is or has been:

- a. Adjudicated mentally incompetent
- b. Committed to any mental institution
- c. Been found by a court to be a mentally ill person, subject to hospitalization by court order
- d. Involuntary patient other than for purposes of observation

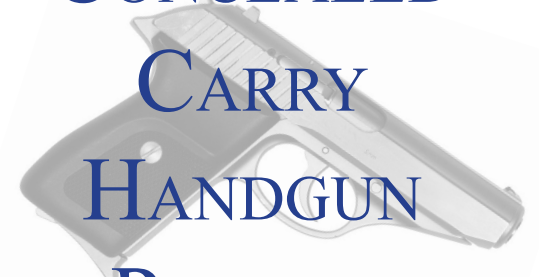

## REQUIREMENTS

In order for an Ohio resident to obtain a concealed carry license they must meet the following requirements, in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Section 2923.125(A):

Must have successfully completed a Ohio Concealed Carry Training Course.

Must be at least 21 years of age.

Must be an Ohio resident, a resident of the county of application (or an adjacent county) , or working in Ohio.

Must have read the current pamphlet available online at [www.OhioAttorneyGeneral.gov](http://www.OhioAttorneyGeneral.gov).

Appointments are required to apply for or renew a Concealed Carry License, please visit our website to make an appointment.

## FEES

***Cash, Money Order, or Cashiers Check only and must be paid at time of appointment.***

- ✓ \$67.00 New Application fee
- ✓ \$50.00 Renewal Application fee
- ✓ \$37.00 Temporary Emergency fee

✓ \$24.00 additional fee if you have **not** been a resident of Ohio for 5 consecutive years.

*All fees are non-refundable. Fees are waived for retired law enforcement personnel (must bring retirement letter).*

## APPOINTMENTS

*Applicants, must bring the following to the scheduled appointment.*

### **New, Renewal (from Franklin Co.) and Emergency Applicants:**

- ✓ Valid photo ID.
- ✓ The appropriate completed application available online at <http://sheriff.franklincountyohio.gov>

### **New, and Emergency Applicants:**

- ✓ One color photo (apx. size 2"x 2") taken within 30 days of the application date.

### **New Applicants:**

- ✓ An original certificate or affidavit of completion for an Ohio Concealed Carry Training Course within 3 years of the date of application for new applicants.

OR

A document that evidences the applicant within 10 years immediately preceding the application date:

- A. Is an active or reserve member of the U.S. Military. Please bring in current Military ID.
- B. Has been honorably discharged from U.S. Military. Please bring in DD214

## DISQUALIFIERS

Applicant will be disqualified if any of the following applies:

1) If applicant has not received required training in past 3 years.

2) If applicant has been CHARGED or UNDER INDICTMENT for:

- a. Any felony
- b. Some drug offenses
- c. Misdemeanor offense of violence
- d. Negligent assault
- e. Falsification to obtain Carry Concealed license
- f. Possess a revoked or suspended Carry Concealed license
- g. Conspiracy or attempt to commit, or complicity in committing, any of the above offenses

3) If applicant has been CONVICTED:

- a. Any felony
- b. Some drug offenses
- c. Domestic Violence
- d. Assault on peace officer
- e. Conspiracy or attempt to commit, or complicity in committing, any of the above offenses

4) If applicant has been convicted under the following offenses within 3 years:

Any misdemeanor offense of violence (*Except resisting arrest, assault on peace officer; possess revoked or suspended CC license*)
