Franklin County Sheriff's Office to Unveil New Body Scanner Device Will be Critical Aid in Keeping Drugs, Other Contraband Out of Jail

Details: In an effort to significantly reduce the amount of potential contraband into the jails, The Franklin County Sheriff's Office will hold a press conference event where Sheriff Dallas Baldwin will unveil Franklin County Corrections' first full-body scanner.

Having been in the planning and procurement stage for two years, the new scanner is a part of the Sheriff's Office's mission to eliminate all forms of contraband at both Corrections facilities. The new scanner will allow for a more detailed, less invasive search of incoming suspects, as well as current inmates.

All reporters will be given a demonstration of the new scanner, an overview of how it works, and will have the opportunity to experience a first-hand scan to show how easy and safe the process is.
