Narrative of Incident Sheriff Baldwin states:

At 8:25 a.m., the Franklin County Sheriff's Office was notified by the School Resource Officer at Westland High School of a possible threat to the security of the school. As a precaution, the school was evacuated, and a thorough search of the campus made.

It was determined that there was no threat of any type and, at approximately 9:15 a.m., the school was deemed clear, and classes resumed.

The Sheriff's Office Detective Bureau has begun an investigation of the situation.
